



VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

Grounds Crew Member

Time Commitment: Approx. 3-4 hours per month. Crew meets the 2nd Saturday of each month for workdays or on an as-needed basis

List of Specific Duties:

- Participate in litter clean-ups including clean-ups in Fassnight Creek
- Maintenance of flower beds and other landscaped areas around the Museum grounds (may include planning and planting of beds)
- Watering of beds as needed
- Other light maintenance work on the Museum grounds
- Assist Museum staff with a variety of tasks as needed

Length of Assignment: This is an ongoing assignment with an indefinite term

Name of Supervisor: Reports to the Facilities Coordinator

Other Requirements:

- May include periods of standing as well as squatting, walking on uneven ground, bending, kneeling, and reaching
- Must be able to lift 30 pounds
- Volunteer must provide appropriate footwear including wading boots for creek clean-up and appropriate apparel for outdoor activities in a variety of weather conditions
- Museum will provide basic tools, equipment, and supplies as well as appropriate training as necessary
- No experience necessary

Working Conditions: Outdoors. May require extended periods of standing or sitting.

Assignment Start Date/End Date: Volunteers start date will coincide with monthly workdays and may be seasonal. There is no specific end date
